### You need to register to attend the AGM

Due to COVID-19 restrictions your Board has determined the safest way to hold the 2021 AGM is via the online channel.

To attend the AGM you will need to register by no later than close of business Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2021.

You have four options to choose how to register to attend the AGM;

To ensure the voting process is independent and confidential we have appointed Vero Engagement & Voting Solutions Pty Ltd ("Vero") to manage and host The Mac AGM via the Vero AGM Portal.

Once we have received and validated your registration form we will issue you a unique link for you to use to login to the Vero AGM portal.

### Proxies

You can appoint a proxy to attend and vote at the meeting on your behalf for the Director Remuneration agenda item. Votes via proxy do not apply to the election of directors by secret ballot.

Your proxy does not have to be a member of the Credit Union. An Appointment of Proxy form is available from any branch of the Credit Union or by phoning 1300 622 278. It includes instructions on how to vote using a proxy. Please read those instructions carefully.

To be valid, your Appointment of Proxy form must reach the Secretary of the Credit Union **no later than close of business Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November, 2021**.
